RESOLUTION RESTRICTING PARKING ALONG CEMETERY ROAD, COUNTY ROAD #679 IN MANNINGTON TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF SALEM

WHEREAS, the County of Salem Correctional Facility requested parking restrictions along both sides of a portion on Cemetery Road, County Road #679; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem Correctional Facility requested the "NO PARKING" designation to prohibit on street parking within the County Right-of-Way from the intersection at Old Salem Road, County Road #678, South on Cemetery Road, County Road #679 for a distance of 3,300 L.F.; and

WHEREAS, the County Warden recommends the following parking restrictions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1. PARKING be and is hereby restricted along both sides of a portion on Cemetery Road, County Road #679 from the intersection at Old Salem Road, County Road #678, South on Cemetery Road, County Road #679 for a distance of 3,300 L.F.
2. The Salem County Road Supervisor is hereby authorized to erect the proper signage as required by law with installation conforming to the standards set forth in the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices".
3. A duly certified copy of this Resolution will be forwarded to the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Transportation along with law enforcement.
