RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE NEW JERSEY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY AND THE COUNTY OF SALEM

WHEREAS, the County of Salem recognizes the importance in developing an infrastructure to support economic growth opportunities; and

WHEREAS, in 2022, the County of Salem established a Salem County Office of Economic Development to facilitate current and future economic opportunities within the County; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Economic Development Authority (NJEDA) recognizes the need to support the implementation of an Economic Development Office in the County of Salem; and

WHEREAS, the NJEDA has awarded the County of Salem funding from the CARES Act Supplementary Planning Grant monies to explore methods to maximize local economic benefits for the development of long-term strategic infrastructure investments within Salem County; and

WHEREAS, the County and the NJEDA desire to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding regarding the provisions of NJEDA support of a Salem County Office of Economic Development; and

WHEREAS, the County agrees to undertake directives outlined in the MOU, including providing matching funds, in exchange for the receipt of funds by NJEDA, specifically in an amount of \$100,000.00 (One Hundred Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem that the Director and Clerk of the Board shall be authorized and directed to execute the the Memorandum of Understanding between the New Jersey Economic Development Authority and the County of Salem.
