RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INTER-COUNTY AGREEMENT FOR THE REGIONAL REHABILITATION AND REENTRY CENTER OF SALEM, GLOUCESTER AND CUMBERLAND COUNTIES

WHEREAS, Cumberland County, Salem County and Gloucester County (the "Parties") having entered into a Memorandum of Understanding to outline the obligations and responsibilities of the Parties to study, negotiate and codify a proposal for the creation of a regional correctional facility in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:65-14, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Parties having entered into negotiations as aforesaid, are desirous of now formalizing the creation, operation and administration of a regional jail by entering into an Inter-County Agreement for the Regional Rehabilitation and Reentry Center of Salem, Gloucester and Cumberland Counties to establish a regional rehabilitation and reentry center authority to design, develop, construct, maintain and operate a regional rehabilitation and reentry center; and

WHEREAS, the Parties recognize that consolidating these services will create long-term cost savings for all parties, will not reduce any prior capabilities, and will improve the interoperability among the Parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners for the County of Salem, as follows:

- 1. That this Board hereby authorizes the Inter-County Agreement for the Regional Rehabilitation and Reentry Center of Salem, Gloucester and Cumberland in the form on file with the Clerk of this Board and approved by County Counsel subject to non-material changes.
2. That the Director of this Board is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Inter-County Agreement for the Regional Rehabilitation and Reentry Center of Salem, Gloucester and Cumberland on behalf of the County of Salem.
