RESOLUTION TO RENEW THE SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENTS PROVIDING EQUIPMENT, LABOR AND SERVICES FOR SALEM COUNTY MUNICIPALITIES

WHEREAS, the County of Salem (Salem) is a body politico and corporate of the State of New Jersey with main offices located at 110 Fifth Street, Salem, NJ 08079; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County municipalities listed below are a body politico and corporate of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Salem County previously entered into a Shared Services Agreement with these Salem County municipalities on September 4, 2019 by Resolution 2019-311 to provide various Equipment, Labor and Services primarily associated with, but not exclusive for Public Works to include Road and Bridge Projects; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:65A-1 et seq. specifically authorized local government units, including counties and municipalities, to enter into shares services agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Purchasing Department has negotiated a Shared Services Agreement with Salem County Municipalities for the period commencing August 1, 2024 through July 31, 2029; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners and the Salem County Municipalities desire to contract for Equipment, Labor, and Services by the County of Salem and the below listed Municipalities, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 a et seq.
