RESOLUTION PROHIBITING NORMAL TRAFFIC ALONG LOTUS AVENUE, COUNTY ROAD #678, SOUTH MAIN STREET, COUNTY ROAD #672 AND MARLTON ROAD, COUNTY ROAD #636 IN THE BOROUGH OF WOODSTOWN FOR AN INDEPENDENCE DAY PARADE

WHEREAS, a request was received from the "Borough of Woodstown" for an Independence Day Parade along a portion of three (3) County Roads: Lotus Avenue, County Road #678 from Bailey Street, County Road #616 to South Main Street, County Road #672; along South Main Street, County Road #672 to N.J. Route #45; and along a portion of Marlton Road, County Road #636 from N.J. Route #45 to the "Woodstown-Pilesgrove Recreation Center" on Thursday, July 4TH, 2024 between the hours of 9:00 AM and 12:00 PM (Noon); and


WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.1 requires a Municipality to receive consent from the County when normal traffic is prohibited by a parade, procession, or assemblage; and

WHEREAS, Lotus Avenue, County Road #678, South Main Street, County Road #672 and Marlton Road, County Road #636 are all roads under the jurisdiction of the County of Salem.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the request to prohibit through traffic for an Independence Day Parade along Lotus Avenue, County Road #678, South Main Street, County Road #672 and Marlton Road, County Road #636 on Thursday, July 4TH, 2024 between the hours of 9:00 AM and 12:00 PM (Noon) is approved subject to the following conditions:

1. Installation of proper detour signs and notice to the Salem County 911 Central Dispatch of the road closures.
2. Flag personnel at both ends of the parade area, and all side streets, and all access areas - to direct traffic.
3. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the local governing body.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Municipal Office of Emergency Management and Law Enforcement with jurisdiction over the location for the preparation of an "Event Safety Analysis".
5. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Public Works Department, the County Message Boards may be available, if requested at least two (2) weeks prior to the event and if needed based on the "Event Safety Analysis".
6. Copies of this Resolution shall also be provided to the Salem County Engineer's Office, the Salem County Office of Emergency Services, and the Salem County Sheriff's Department.
