RESOLUTION RESTRICTING PARKING ALONG BAILEY STREET, COUNTY ROAD #616 IN THE TOWNSHIP OF PILESGROVE, COUNTY OF SALEM

WHEREAS, the Township of Pilesgrove and the Borough of Woodstown requested parking restrictions along both sides of a portion on Bailey Street, County Road #616; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Pilesgrove requested the "NO STOPPING OR STANDING" designation due to safety concerns in the area of Baileys Corner Housing Complex; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has investigated the said portion of Bailey Street, County Road # 616 described as from Hillcrest Drive to Parker Place, both Township roads and recommends the following parking restrictions per Pilesgrove Township Resolution #24-026 and Borough of Woodstown Resolution #2024-39.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1. STOPPING AND STANDING be and is hereby restricted along both sides of Bailey Street, County Road #616 from Hillcrest Drive to Parker Place, both Township Roads.
2. The Salem County Road Supervisor be and is hereby authorized to erect the proper signage as required by law with installation conforming to the standards set forth in the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices".
3. A duly certified copy of this Resolution will be forwarded to the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Transportation along with law enforcement.

SIGNS ALONG BAILEY STREET BY THE BAILEYS CORNER HOUSING COMPLEX**


WHEREAS, during the past few months there has been an increase of parked vehicles including a bus along Bailey Street, and
