RESOLUTION TO APPLY FOR FUNDING FOR THE SUSTAINING LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners desires to apply for a grant with the New Jersey Association of County and City Health Officials (NJACCHO), Sustaining Local Public Health Infrastructure Grant; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this grant is to provide critical resources to state, local, and territorial health departments in support of a wide range of COVID-19/SARS-CoV-2 testing and epidemiologic surveillance related activities; and

WHEREAS, NJACCHO has made funding available to aid in this endeavor for the period of July 1st, 2024, through March 31st, 2026, in the amount of \$168,049.00 (One Hundred, Sixty-Eight Thousand, Forty-Nine Dollars and Zero Cents).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized to sign the resolution to apply for the New Jersey Association of County and City Health Officials (NJACCHO), Sustaining Local Public Health Infrastructure Grant.
