RESOLUTION PROHIBITING NORMAL TRAFFIC ALONG A PORTION OF EAST MAIN STREET, COUNTY ROAD #675 IN THE BOROUGH OF PENNS GROVE FOR THE PENNS GROVE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT CONGRESS HOMECOMING DAY PARADE

WHEREAS, a request was received from the "Borough of Penns Grove" for the PENNS GROVE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT CONGRESS HOMECOMING DAY PARADE along a portion of East Main Street, County Road #675 beginning at the intersection of Barber Avenue, a local road, continuing eastward along East Main Street, County Road #675 to the intersection of U.S. Route #130 and N.J. Route #48 on Friday, September 27th, 2024 between the hours of 4:30 PM and 6:30 PM; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.1 requires a Municipality to receive consent from the County when normal traffic is prohibited by a parade, procession, or assemblage; and

WHEREAS, East Main Street, County Road #675 is a road under the jurisdiction of the County of Salem.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the request to prohibit through traffic for the PENNS GROVE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT CONGRESS HOMECOMING DAY PARADE along a portion of East Main Street, County Road #675 on Friday, September 27th, 2024 between the hours of 4:30 PM and 6:30 PM is approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Installation of proper detour signs and notice to the Salem County 911 Central Dispatch of the road closure.
2. Flag personnel at both ends of the parade area, and all side streets, and all access areas - to direct traffic.
3. Proper approval must be received from the New Jersey Department of Transportation for closure of the balance of the Parade route designated as New Jersey Route #48, in the Borough of Penns Grove and Township of Carneys Point.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the local governing body; as well as Carneys Point Township, the adjacent governing body.
5. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to both Municipal Offices of Emergency Management and both Municipal Law Enforcement Offices with jurisdiction over the parade route for the preparation of an "Event Safety Analysis".
6. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Public Works Department, the County Message Boards may be available, if requested at least two (2) weeks prior to the event and if needed based on the "Event Safety Analysis".
7. Copies of this Resolution shall also be provided to the Salem County Engineer's Office, the Salem County Office of Emergency Services, and the Salem County Sheriff's Department.
