RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING THE SUSTAINING LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT

WHEREAS, the Salem County Department of Health and Human Services has applied and obtained the Sustaining Local Public Health Infrastructure Grant from the New Jersey Association of County and City Health Officials (NJACCHO), to provide critical resources to state, local, and territorial health departments in support of a wide range of COVID-19/SARS-CoV-2 testing and epidemiologic surveillance related activities; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Association of County and City Health Officials (NJACCHO) has awarded the amount of \$168,049.00 (One Hundred Sixty-Eight Thousand, Forty-Nine Dollars and Zero Cents) for the period of July 1st, 2024 through March 31st, 2026; and

WHEREAS, no matching funds are required.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized to sign the resolution accepting and executing the Sustaining Local Public Health Infrastructure Grant from the New Jersey Association of County and City Health Officials (NJACCHO).
