RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONSENT TO THE PROPOSED WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT (WQM) PLAN AMENDMENT TITLED "638 GERSHAL AVENUE WAREHOUSE" IN PITTSGROVE TOWNSHIP SITE SPECIFIC AREA AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners wants to provide for the orderly development of wastewater conveyance and treatment facilities within the County; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection ("NJDEP") requires that proposed wastewater treatment and conveyance facilities and wastewater treatment service areas, as well as related subjects, be in conformance with an approved "Water Quality Management" (WQM) plan; and

WHEREAS, the NJDEP has established the WQM plan amendment procedure through the WQMP rules at N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5 as the method of incorporating unplanned facilities into a WQM plan; and

WHEREAS, a proposed WQM plan amendment publicly noticed in the New Jersey Register on April 15, 2024 for "638 Gershal Avenue" (Block 3101, Portions of Lots 8-16) in Pittsgrove Township, Program Interest 435441, Activity Number AMD230004, has been prepared by "Colliers Engineering and Design, Inc."; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has reviewed the proposed amendments to the Lower Delaware Water Quality Management Plan for "638 Gershal Avenue", Program Interest No. 435441, Activity No. AMD230004, and has no objection to the approval of the WQM plan amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1. The County hereby consents to the "638 Gershal Avenue Amendment" Program Interest No. 435441, Activity No. AMD230004, in Pittsgrove Township and publicly noticed in the New Jersey Register on April 15, 2024, prepared by "Colliers Engineering and Design, Inc." for the purpose of its incorporation into the applicable WQM plan(s).
2. This consent shall be submitted to NJDEP pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5(g)6.
