RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SALEM AND THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND FOR THE HOUSING OF ADULT MALE AND FEMALE INMATES

WHEREAS, the County of Salem recognizes the essential purpose of promoting public safety, efficiency and economy while providing the best care and conditions for adult inmates detained in accordance with the law and orders of the Courts; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Jail has the capacity to house the entire inmate population of Salem County as well as a portion of the inmate population of Cumberland County; and

WHEREAS, providing for the detention of Cumberland County’s adult inmates in the Salem County Jail will result in a more economical operation of the Salem County Jail; and

WHEREAS, The Salem County Board of County Commissioners wish to enter into a Shared Services Agreement for the provision of adult male and female inmate housing; a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, this agreement is authorized pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5; and

WHEREAS, The Salem County Board of County Commissioners now wish to authorize the aforesaid Shared Services Agreement with the County of Cumberland;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem as follows:

1. The Shared Services Agreement Between the County of Salem and the County of Cumberland for the housing of adult male and female inmates is hereby approved in the form on file with the Clerk of the Board and in the form as approved by County Counsel and subject to non-material changes.
2. The contract shall commence retroactively on June 1 2024, and terminate on May 31, 2025.
3. The Director, or his designee, and the Clerk of the Board are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, if necessary, to effectuate the full intent and purpose of this Agreement.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Division of Local Government Services.
