RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING A GRANT FOR THE DMHAS BIPARTISAN SAFER COMMUNITIES ACT DISASTER RESPONSE CRISIS COUNSELING COUNTY GRANT 2024-2025

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners has obtained a grant from The New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health & Addiction Services to address the shortage of Disaster Response Crisis Counselors (DRCC's) state-wide support training and sustaining DRCCs in their respective counties; and

WHEREAS, New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health & Addiction Services, has made funding available to address the shortage of Disaster Response Crisis Counselors for the period of October 17, 2024, through September 29, 2025; and

WHEREAS, grant funding has been awarded from New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health & Addiction Services in the amount of \$30,000.00 (Thirty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) for the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act Disaster Response Crisis Counseling County Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salem County Board of County Commissioners hereby accepts and executes a grant from The New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health & Addiction Services for the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act Disaster Response Crisis Counseling for the grant period of October 17, 2024, through September 29, 2025, in the amount of \$30,000.00 (Thirty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents).
