RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REQUEST FROM THE BOROUGH OF WOODSTOWN AUTHORIZING NJ TRANSIT TO INSTALL BUS STOPS ALONG BAILEY STREET, COUNTY ROAD #616, SOUTH MAIN STREET, COUNTY ROAD #672 AND ALLOWAY-WOODSTOWN ROAD, COUNTY ROAD #603

WHEREAS, the County of Salem received Resolution #2024-67 adopted by the Borough of Woodstown on June 11, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned resolution requests approval from the Salem County Board of County Commissioners for the establishment of five (5) NJ Transit Bus Stop locations along three (3) County Roads described as follows and shown on the attached map:

1. Bailey Street, County Road #616- Northbound on the easterly side thereof:
 - I. Intersection of Woodstown-Alloway Road, County Road #603 – Near side. Beginning at the southerly curb line of Woodstown-Alloway Road, County Road #603 and extending 105 feet southerly therefrom (NJ Transit Location #33305);
2. South Main Street, County Road #672 – Northbound on the easterly side thereof:
 - I. Intersection of East Millbrooke Avenue, Local Road – near side. Beginning at the southerly curb line of East Millbrooke Avenue, Local Road, and extending 105 feet southerly therefrom (NJ Transit Location #28136);
3. South Main Street, County Road #672 – Southbound on the westerly side thereof:
 - I. Intersection of Hunt Street, Local Road – near side. Beginning at the northerly curb line of Hunt Street, Local Road, and extending 105 feet northerly therefrom (NJ Transit Location #28132);
 - II. Intersection of West Millbrooke Avenue, Local Road – far side. Beginning at the southerly curb line of West Millbrooke Avenue, Local Road, and extending 100 feet southerly therefrom (NJ Transit Location #28133);
4. Woodstown-Alloway Road, County Road #603 – southbound on the westerly side thereof:
 - I. Intersection of Bailey Street, County Road #616 – far side. Beginning at the southerly curb line of Bailey Street, County Road #616 and extending 100 feet southerly therefrom (NJ Transit Location #33308); and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners will agree with the establishment of the NJ Transit Bus Stop locations described above subject to the following conditions:

1. No cost to Salem County for the establishment nor maintenance of the NJ Transit Bus Stop signs, locations and/or shelters; and
2. No responsibility or liability to the County of Salem for the NJ Transit Bus Stop signs, locations and/or shelters; and

WHEREAS, customers who utilize the NJ Transit 468 Line – Carneys Point to Salem, and the NJ Transit 401 Line – Salem to Philadelphia initiated the need for NJ Transit Bus Stop signs, locations and/or shelters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the County of Salem does herein agree with the establishment of the additional "NJ Transit" Bus Stops as outlined above with the understanding that there is no cost, maintenance, responsibility nor liability on the part of Salem County; and

BE IT FURETHER RESOLVED that a signed and sealed copy of this resolution will be forwarded to the "Borough of Woodstown" and "NJ Transit".
