RESOLUTION TO APPROVE "SOUTH JERSEY REGIONAL ANIMAL SHELTER" APPLICATION FOR MOTORIST SOLICITATION IN PITTSGROVE TOWNSHIP PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION NO. 98-115

WHEREAS, the "South Jersey Regional Animal Shelter", with the consent and approval of Pittsgrove Township has applied to the County of Salem for a permit to solicit contributions on the roadway at the intersection of Almond Road, County Road #540 and Parvin Mill Road, County Road #645 in Pittsgrove Township on Sunday, September 22, 2024, between the hours of 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM, Rain Date – Sunday, September 29, 2024 between the hours of 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-60 requires a Charitable Organization to receive consent from the governing body that has jurisdiction over the roads slated to be utilized; and

WHEREAS, the "South Jersey Regional Animal Shelter" has secured the required permission from Pittsgrove Township, dated July 24, 2024; and .

WHEREAS, the intersection noted above is under the jurisdiction of the County of Salem; and

WHEREAS, compliance with all provisions and restrictions of Resolution No. 98-115 must be effectuated by the applicant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that a permit be executed by the Clerk of the Salem County Board of County Commissioners to the "South Jersey Regional Animal Shelter" for the dates and times memorialized above to submit to the following conditions:

- 1. All solicitors must wear a safety vest in accordance with NJ DOT standards.
2. At least two (2) warning signs on each entrance to the intersection as follows:
a. "Charitable Solicitation 500 feet ahead"; and
b. Second sign identifying the Organization soliciting.
3. A copy of this Resolutions shall be provided to the local governing body.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the municipal Office of Emergency Management and Law Enforcement with jurisdiction over the location for the preparation of an "Event Safety Analysis".
5. Copies of this Resolution shall also be provided to the Salem County Engineer's Office, the Salem County Office of Emergency Management and the Salem County Sheriff's Department.
