RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE INSERTION OF ANY SPECIAL ITEM OF REVENUE IN THE BUDGET PURSUANT TO NJSA 40A:4-87 CHAPTER 159, P.L. 1948

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any county or municipality when such item of revenue shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, said Director may also approve the insertion of an item of appropriation of equal amount.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Salem hereby request the Director of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget for the year 2024 in the sum of \$2,589,984.00 (Two Million, Five Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand, Nine Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars and Zero Cents), which is now available as an item of revenue from the New Jersey Department of Transportation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the like sum of \$2,589,984.00 (Two Million, Five Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand, Nine Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars and Zero Cents) is hereby appropriated under the caption FY24 Rail Freight Assistance Program Grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the sum of \$287,776.00 (Two Hundred Eighty-Seven Thousand, Seven Hundred Seventy-Six Dollars and Zero Cents) representing the amount required for the County's share of the aforementioned undertaking appears in the budget of the year 2024 under the caption Matching Funds for Grants and is hereby appropriated under the caption FY24 Freight Assistance Program Grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified electronic copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Division of Local Government Services.
