RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING A GRANT FROM THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL FOR THE 2024 HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREAS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners (the Board) recognizes the need to assist the Prosecutor’s Office and law enforcement in endeavors to effectively prevent and deter drug trafficking in this County; and

WHEREAS, the Office of National Drug Control Policy approved grant funding for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Office of the Attorney General; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem is a sub-recipient of grant funding from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Office of the Attorney General, in accordance with the Notice of Award letter and Grant Agreement on file; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the funding amount is for the period January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2025, with a total funding of \$80,000.00 (Eighty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the 2024 High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas Program be accepted and executed.
