**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES DIVISION OF AGING SERVICES TO APPLY FOR THE AGE-FRIENDLY GRANT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners authorizes the Salem County Office on Aging and Disabilities to submit an application to the New Jersey Department of Human Services Division of Aging Services for the Age-Friendly Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Salem intends to apply for funding in the amount of \$70,000.00 (Seventy Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) for the period from January 1, 2025, to June 30, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant will provide financial assistance to conduct a comprehensive Community Needs Assessment for Salem County, and based on the data collected, develop a strategic plan to make Salem County an age-friendly community, promoting the health, well-being, and quality of life for older adults and individuals with disabilities; and

**WHEREAS**, no matching funds are required for this grant, however in-kind match should be considered.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Salem County Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes Salem County Office on Aging and Disabilities to apply for and secure the above mentioned grant funding on behalf of the County of Salem.
