RESOLUTION PROHIBITING NORMAL TRAFFIC ALONG A PORTION OF WEST MAIN STREET, COUNTY ROAD #675 IN THE BOROUGH OF PENNS GROVE FOR THE PENNS GROVE ELKS LODGE #1358 MOTORCYCLE CHARITY RUN TO BENEFIT THE QUINTON WEIGLE VO-TECH SCHOLARSHIP FUND

WHEREAS, a request was received from the "Borough of Penns Grove" for the Penns Grove Elks Lodge #1358 Motorcycle Charity Run to Benefit The Quiton Weigle Vo-Tech Scholarship Fund for an assemblage along a portion of West Main Street, County Road #675 beginning at the intersection of State Street, County Road #634, continuing westward along West Main Street, County Road #675 to the intersection of Naylor Avenue, a local road on Saturday, October 5th, 2024 between the hours of 10:00 AM and 7:00 PM (rain date, Sunday, October 6th, 2024 between the hours of 10:00 AM and 7:00 PM); and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.1 requires a Municipality to receive consent from the County when normal traffic is prohibited by a parade, procession, or assemblage; and

WHEREAS, West Main Street, County Road #675 is a road under the jurisdiction of the County of Salem.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the request to prohibit through traffic for an ASSEMBLAGE along a portion of West Main Street, County Road #675 on Saturday, October 5th, 2024 between the hours of 10:00 AM and 7:00 PM (rain date, Sunday, October 6th, 2024 between the hours of 10:00 AM and 7:00 PM) is approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Installation of proper detour signs and notice to the Salem County 911 Central Dispatch of the road closure.
2. Flag personnel at both ends of the assemblage area, and all side streets, and all access areas - to direct traffic.
3. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the local governing body.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Municipal Office of Emergency Management and Municipal Law Enforcement Office with jurisdiction over the assemblage area for the preparation of an "Event Safety Analysis".
5. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Public Works Department, the County Message Boards may be available, if requested at least two (2) weeks prior to the event and if needed based on the "Event Safety Analysis".
6. Copies of this Resolution shall also be provided to the Salem County Engineer's Office, the Salem County Office of Emergency Services, and the Salem County Sheriff's Department.
