RESOLUTION PROHIBITING NORMAL TRAFFIC ALONG THE SOUTHERN PORTION OF POINTERS-AUBURN ROAD, COUNTY ROAD #646 IN PILESGROVE AND CARNEYS POINT TOWNSHIPS FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF POINTERS-AUBURN ROAD AND THE U.S. ROUTE #40 TRAFFIC SIGNAL

WHEREAS, a request was received from N.J.D.O.T., North Point Development and South State Inc. for the Temporary Road Closure of Pointers-Auburn Road, County Road #646 for the reconstruction of the roadway, installation of stormwater drainage facilities and the installation of traffic control devices for the new N.J.D.O.T. signal at U.S. Route #40 and Pointers-Auburn Road, County Road #646 as part of the U.S. Route #40 & N.J. Route #48 Consolidated Improvements. This road closure will start at the N.J. Route #40 intersection and proceed South to the intersection of Courses Landing Road, County Road #628.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.3 Permits an emergent or temporary condition which dictates adoption of special traffic regulations for up to 90 days; and

WHEREAS, Pointers-Auburn Road, County Road #646 is a road under the jurisdiction of the County of Salem.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the request to prohibit through traffic on Pointers-Auburn Road, County Road #646 is approved AND subject to the following conditions:

1. Installation of proper detour signs and V.M.S. boards supplied by the contractor.
2. At all times the roadway must be accessible to Emergency Vehicles.
3. Road Closure shall not be more than eight (8) weeks from the date of Notice of Construction given to the Salem County Engineer's office.
4. Weekly Notice to the Salem County 911 Central Dispatch of the road closure will be made by the contractor.
5. No Construction Traffic with G.V.W.R. of 10,000 pounds or greater will be permitted on Courses Landing Road, County Road #628 during this closure.
6. All Detoured Traffic will use Hawks Bridge Road, County Road #540 and the remaining sections of Pointers-Auburn Road, County Road #646.
7. Any Pavement Damage to Courses Landing Road, County Road #628, resulting from detoured heavy truck traffic of G.V.W.R. of 10,000 pounds or greater, will be required to repave those portions of road to County Standards at the Developers/Construction company's expense.
8. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the local governing body.
9. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Municipal Office of Emergency Management and Municipal Law Enforcement Office with jurisdiction over the area.
10. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Public Works Department.
11. Copies of this Resolution shall also be provided to the Salem County Engineer's Office, the Salem County Office of Emergency Services, and the Salem County Sheriff's Department.
