RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE 2025 COMPREHENSIVE ALCOHOLISM AND DRUG ABUSE SERVICES CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the New Jersey State Department of Human Services intends to grant the Salem County Board of County Commissioners funds derived from the Alcoholic Beverage Tax and other State funding under authority of P.L. 1983, Chapter 51; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of Chapter 51 funds awarded under the grant will be \$259,404.00 (Two Hundred Fifty Nine Thousand, Four Hundred and Four Dollars and Zero Cents) to be utilized for the provision of alcohol and drug rehabilitation services for Salem County residents; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires a cash match of \$24,703.00 (Twenty Four Thousand, Seven Hundred and Three Dollars and Zero Cents); and

WHEREAS, the Salem Treasurer has certified that the funding for this grant in 2025 shall be encumbered in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4 and this agreement shall further be contingent upon the availability and appropriation of sufficient funds for the purpose in the County's temporary and/or permanent budget.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem that the Commissioner Director and the Health and Human Services Executive Director shall be authorized to sign an application for a health service grant for the provision of alcoholism and drug abuse treatment services for the period of January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025.
