**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE AND EXECUTION OF A GRANT FROM THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR QUAKER NECK ROAD, COUNTY ROAD #657, PHASE II DESIGN – PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING IN MANNINGTON AND ALLOWAY TOWNSHIP FOR THE COUNTY OF SALEM FEDERAL PROJECT NO. 0657301, NJDOT JOB NO. 7106001**

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Transportation has made funds available under the Fiscal Year 2024 Federal Highway Administration; and

**WHEREAS**, the Salem County Engineer’s Office made application to the New Jersey Department of Transportation for funds from the Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBGP) for Fiscal Year 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Transportation has obligated funds for the “Fiscal Year 2024 Federal Highway Administration Project Fund” in the amount of \$149,908.40 (One Hundred, Forty-Nine Thousand, Nine Hundred Eight Dollars and Forty Cents) for the project listed below:

1. **QUAKER NECK ROAD, COUNTY ROAD #657** from the Salem City/Mannington Township Boundary (MP 1.30) to Kerlin Road, a local road (MP 5.65) in Mannington and Alloway Township a distance of approximately 4.35 miles – **DESIGN – PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING**; and

**WHEREAS**, no funding match is required for this Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the Grant and Project are to be referred to as the Fiscal Year 2024 STBGP QUAKER NECK ROAD (CR 657) PHASE II – DESIGN – PE.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

1. The GRANT AGREEMENT, as received from the New Jersey Department of Transportation, be accepted and executed by the Director of the Salem County Board of County Commissioners and attested to by the Clerk to the Salem County Board of County Commissioners.
2. The Chief Finance Officer and the contact person from the Salem County Engineer’s Office, as well as other necessary parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all Grant requirements and documentation fillings as directed by the New Jersey Department of Transportation.
3. Four (4) fully executed copies of this resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Engineer’s Office forthwith.
