RESOLUTION ACCEPTING FUNDING FOR THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TICK SURVEILLANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners recognizes the importance of a Tick Surveillance program in Salem County; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners authorized resolution 2018-218 Designating the Salem County Mosquito Control Division to provide Surveillance, Education, Training and Recommendations on Integrated Pest Management for the Management of Ticks and Tick-Borne Diseases and to Provide Appropriate Tick-Borne Management Activities; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Health is providing funding in the amount of \$12,000.00 (Twelve Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) with no match to support the development and implementation of routine tick surveillance activities to certain counties in New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem Mosquito Control Agency was selected as a recipient of said funding for immediate program support and unexpended funds must be returned to New Jersey Department of Health no later than September 12, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1. The funding amount be accepted and expended for the NJDOH Tick Surveillance Program.
