



Ordinance No. 2024-002

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF SALEM, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$5,000,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE COMPLETION OF VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND THE ACQUISITION OF VARIOUS CAPITAL EQUIPMENT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF SALEM, NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$5,000,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund of the County of Salem, New Jersey ("County") for the completion of various capital improvements and the acquisition of various capital equipment, including: (i) \$1,000,000 for improvements to county facilities, including but not limited to, replacement of roofs and all components related thereto; (ii) \$1,125,000 for improvements to various county roads and bridges, including construction, engineering, design, testing and inspection; (iii) \$2,775,000 for the acquisition of capital equipment and improvements for the Department of Public Works, including but not limited to, reconstruction and remediation of the fuel depot and all components related thereto; and, (iv) \$100,000 for the acquisition and installation of various technology equipment, and improvements thereto.


Section 2. It is hereby determined and stated that the improvements set forth in Section 1 are general capital improvements and are not a current expense.

Section 3. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith, and the resolution promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the County Clerk and available for inspection.

Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication as required by law.
