RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SALEM AND THE BOROUGH OF PENNS GROVE FOR THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, in order to help defray the costs associated with providing emergency medical services to residents within the County of Salem, the County of Salem wishes to incentivize the continuation of services provided by its Municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a Shared Services Agreement with the Borough of Penns Grove to provide Emergency Medical and Ambulance Services ("Services") within the County by paying the municipality \$150.00 (One Hundred, Fifty Dollars and Zero Cents) per call for all calls responded to by the Municipality within the confines of the County of Salem; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Penns Grove is a provider of Emergency Medical Ambulance services in the State of New Jersey, and agrees to perform the Services for the County as provided in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., specifically authorizes local government units, including counties and municipalities, to enter into shared services agreements; and

WHEREAS, The Salem County Board of County Commissioners now wish to authorize the aforesaid Shared Services Agreement with the Borough of Penns Grove.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners as follows:

- 1. The Shared Services Agreement Between the County of Salem and the Borough of Penns Grove for the Provision of Emergency Medical Services is hereby approved in the form on file with the Clerk of the Board and in the form as approved by County Counsel and subject to non-material changes.
2. The contract shall commence retroactively on January 1, 2024, and terminate on June 30, 2025.
3. The Director, or his designee, and the Clerk of the Board are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, if necessary, to effectuate the full intent and purpose of this Agreement.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Division of Local Government Services.
