RESOLUTION PROHIBITING NORMAL TRAFFIC ALONG PENNSVILLE PEDRICKTOWN ROAD, COUNTY ROAD #601 IN OLDMANS TOWNSHIP FOR THE INSTALATION OF A WATER MAIN AND SERVICE TAPS

WHEREAS, a request was received from New Jersey American Water for The Temporary Road Closure of Pennsville Pedricktown Road, County Road #601, for the installation of a water main, service taps, meter pits and the reconstruction of the roadway as part of New Jersey American Water service expansion in Oldman's township. This road closure will start at Perkintown Road, County Road 644 intersection and proceed North for One (1) mile to the intersection of New Road.

WHEREAS, due to the presence of two (2) South Jersey Gas high pressure gas transmission mains that require additional safety precautions, it will be necessary to close the road to allow for safe and proper excavation over the affected gas mains.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.3 Permits an emergent or temporary condition which dictates adoption of special traffic regulations for up to 90 days; and

WHEREAS, Pennsville Pedricktown, County Road #601 is a road under the jurisdiction of the County of Salem.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the request to prohibit through traffic on Pennsville Pedricktown, County Road #601 is approved and subject to the following conditions:

1. NJAW will follow all requirements as outlined in the Salem County Road Opening Permit.
2. NJAW will coordinate all excavation work over the affected gas mains with South Jersey Gas.
3. NJAW will complete all excavation and temporary pavement work in 45 calendar days or less.
4. NJAW will provide proper written notification of all road work activities to impacted residents.
5. NJAW will only close the roadway daily during the hours of 7:00 am to 3:30pm.
6. NJAW will at all times maintain the roadway to be accessible for Emergency Vehicles, School Buses, Trash Trucks and Residents.
7. NJAW will repave full width PENNSVILLE PEDRICKTOWN ROAD to County Standards 90 days after all excavation has been completed, per their approved pavement plans.
8. Road Closure shall not be more than **6 weeks** from the date of "Notice of Construction" given to the Salem County Engineers office.
9. Weekly Notice to the Salem County 911 Central Dispatch of the road closure will be made by the contractor.
10. Per NJSA 27:3A-2 NJAW will Provide and Install proper detour signs and VMS boards.
11. Per NJSA 27:3-6 & 27:3-7 All Detoured Traffic will use an approved Traffic Control Plan.
12. Per NJSA 27:3-3, 27:3-4 & 27:3-8 NJAW will be responsible for any Pavement Damage along the approved detour route and will be required to repave those portions of road to County Standards at NJAW expense.

13. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the following Municipal bodies: Office of Emergency Management, Municipal Law Enforcement, Local Governing Body.
14. Copies of this Resolution shall also be provided to the following Salem County Departments: Engineer's Office, Office of Emergency Services, Sheriff's Department, Public Works Department.
