RESOLUTION APPOINTING THE PUBLIC AGENCY COMPLIANCE OFFICER FOR THE COUNTY OF SALEM

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-3.3, a Public Agency must annually designate an officer to serve as its Public Agency Compliance Officer (P.A.C.O.); and

WHEREAS, the P.A.C.O. is responsible for assuring that no public contract may be awarded nor any monies paid until the prospective contractor has agreed to contract performance which complies with an approved affirmative action program; and

WHEREAS, the P.A.C.O., as the liaison official for matters concerning P.L. 1975, c.127 (N.J.A.C. 17:27), shall have the authority to make appropriate corrections to the County’s contracting procedures if required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners as follows:

1. The allegations of the preamble are incorporated herein by reference.
2. **Jeffrey Ridgway, Jr.** is hereby appointed as the Public Agency Compliance Officer for the County of Salem’s 2025 fiscal year.
3. A certified copy of this Resolution shall be filed with the Department of Treasury, State Affirmative Action Office.
