RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING A GRANT FROM THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES SET-ASIDE PROGRAM FUNDING FOR THE 2025 SALEM COUNTY RAILROAD MULTI-USE PATH PHASE 1

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation has made available funds under the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program for the 2025 Salem County Railroad Multi-Use Path Phase 1; and

WHEREAS, Resolution Number 2025-204 adopted by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners on May 7, 2025, Authorized the Filing of the Application; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation has authorized \$1,264,000.00 (One Million, Two Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) for the 2025 Salem County Railroad Multi-Use Path Phase 1 Project described as the Construction of a Multi-Use Path as well as benches, bicycle racks and other facilities along the Salem County Railroad from the Borough of Woodstown to the Salem County/Gloucester County Line; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program funding for the 2025 Salem County Railroad Multi-Use Path Phase 1 should be authorized prior to incurring any project related costs; and

WHEREAS, the 2025 Salem County Railroad Multi-Use Path Phase 1 Project should be implemented prior to December 17, 2027.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salem County Board of County Commissioners formally approves the Grant Application for the above stated project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Director and Clerk of the Board are hereby authorized to sign the Grant Agreement on behalf of the County of Salem and that their signatures constitute acceptance of the Terms of Conditions of the Grant Agreement and approves the execution of the Grant Agreement.
