RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN CUMBERLAND COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY AND SALEM COUNTY FOR SNOW REMOVAL SERVICES AT FENWICK PLAZA

WHEREAS, the Cumberland County Improvement Authority and County of Salem both have the legal authority under the Uniform Shared Service and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq. (the "Act") to enter into a Shared Service Agreement with any local unit to provide or receive any service that each local unit could perform on its own; and

WHEREAS, each entity seeks to lower costs of services to their respective residents and each desires to seek ways to share and/or consolidate services where possible; and

WHEREAS, for purposes of efficiencies and cost savings, Salem County and the Cumberland County Improvement Authority have negotiated this Agreement between Salem County and the Cumberland County Improvement Authority with respect to Salem County providing snow removal services at the Fenwick Plaza location owned by the Cumberland County Improvement Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the County of Salem and the Governing Body of the Cumberland County Improvement Authority are desirous of entering into an Agreement to allow the entities to work cooperatively as described in the Scope of Services attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to accomplish the foregoing, the Cumberland County Improvement Authority and Salem County are desirous of entering into a Shared Service Agreement in an effort to foster and promote the foregoing purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners as follows:

- 1. That the Shared Service Agreement between Salem County and the Cumberland County Improvement Authority be approved for Snow Removal Services.
2. That the Director and Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized to execute said agreement in the form on file.
