RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION 2025-218 TO ACCEPT AND EXECUTE CY25 INNOVATIONS GRANT FUNDING AWARD #JDAI-25-1F FOR JUVENILE DETENTION ALTERNATIVE INITIATIVE (JDAI) PROGRAMMING FOR THE SALEM COUNTY YOUTH SERVICES COMMISSION (YSC) FROM THE NEW JERSEY JUVENILE JUSTICE COMMISSION BY EXTENDING THE GRANT REIMBURSEMENT PERIOD

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") recognizes a continuing need to assist the Salem County Youth Services Commission ("SCYSC") and County Council on Juvenile Systems Improvement ("CJJSI") in efforts to provide approved Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative ("JDAI") Innovations programming for youth adjudicated delinquents; and

WHEREAS, the SCYSC and CJJSI approved the acceptance and execution of the grant application from the New Jersey Justice Commission for the JDAI Grant Program in accordance with the certified assurances, grant conditions, and award notice on file with the Clerk of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the subrecipients of the funding shall be Salem County Vocational Technical School and the New Jersey Judiciary Cumberland/Gloucester/Salem Vicinage, who are authorized to accept and do accept the subaward for the purpose described in the grant application; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the grant reimbursement for a one-year period from January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2025, with total funding of \$120,000.00 (One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents); and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety Youth Justice Commission has extended the reimbursement period until March 31, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners as follows:

- 1. The project grant on file with the Clerk of the Board is approved and accepted.
2. The Commissioner Director, the Chief Finance Officer, the Salem County Youth Services Administrator from the Salem County Inter-Agency Council of Human Services Inc., and any other necessary parties are hereby authorized and directed to execute all project grant documents provided by the Juvenile Justice Commission.
3. Three fully executed copies of this resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Inter-Agency Council of Human Services forthwith.
