RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION FOR MEDICAL SUPPLIES FROM THE SALEM COUNTY HEALTH AND WELLNESS FOUNDATION FOR THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, Cooper University Hospital is a Level 1 Trauma Center in Southern NJ; and

WHEREAS, Cooper University Health Care Section of Military, Diplomatic, and Field Surgical Affairs (MILDAF) currently trains emergency responders, has agreed to provide Severe Situation Point of Injury Training for the Local governmental and First Responder Agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners has approved a Memorandum of Understanding between the Salem County Sheriff's Office/Office of Emergency Management and the Cooper University Health Care Section of MILDAF; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Health and Wellness Foundation was founded in 2002 in order to promote Health and Wellness for the residents of Salem County NJ through grants; and

WHEREAS, the application will result in a Grant to the Salem County Sheriff's Office funding to be for the spring of 2026, in the amount of \$3,000.00 (Three Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) which will be utilized for medical supplies during the Severe Situation Point of Injury Training provided by Cooper University Health Care Section MILDAF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the Board approves a grant application to the Salem County Health and Wellness Foundation to the amount of \$3,000.00 (Three Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) which will be utilized to purchase medical supplies for the Severe Situation Point of Injury Training provided by Cooper University Health Care Section MILDAF and authorizes the County Sheriff, the Chief Finance Officer and the Project Contact person from the Salem County Sheriff's Office as well as any other necessary parties, to execute all project grant documents with the Salem County Health and Wellness Foundation.
