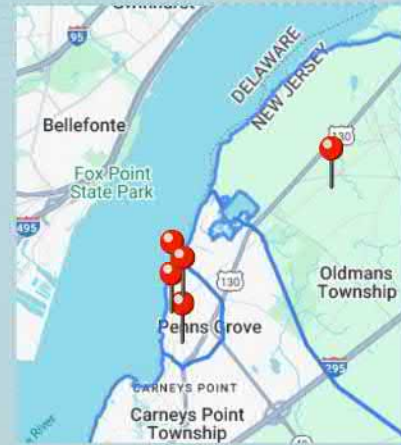

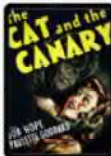

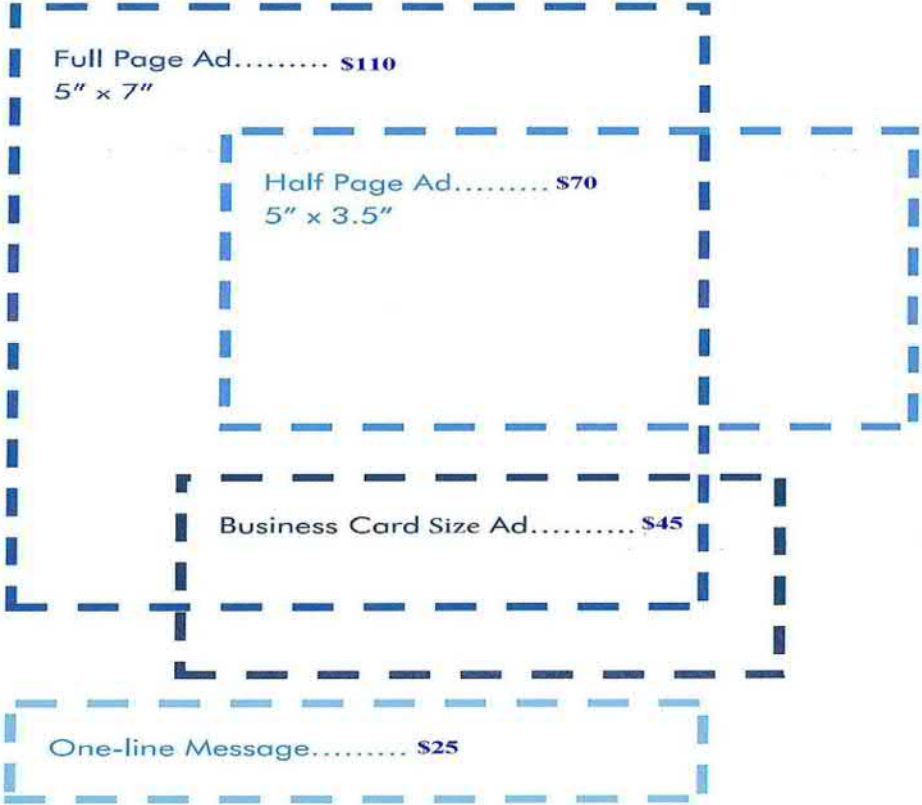

- Students in grades kindergarten to twelfth by the April 30, 2026 deadline who are enrolled in a public, private or parochial school or home study program in Pennsville schools.

### What is the Scholarship Amount?

- The first-place winner from each grade \$100.00
- The second-place winner from each grade \$50.00
- The third-place winner from each grade \$25.00

### What are the Scholarship Submission Requirements?

- Students need to take the initiative to participate individually (outside class time)
- Art must be on canvas or paper. Watercolor, pencil, pastel, charcoal, tempera, crayon, acrylic, pen, ink, oil, marker or other media taught may be used.
- Artwork must serve as a visual narrative capturing the essence of the American 250th Anniversary, symbolizing ideals like freedom, liberty, and national pride.
- May include patriotic kids, Uncle Sam, balloons, fireworks, flag, hat, bow, butterfly, eagle, cupcakes or the bold strokes depicting the American flag to the majestic presence of the bald eagle, patriotic paintings offer a window into the heart of a nation.
- Submit canvas entries on a stretcher frame or canvas board. Reinforce the back with heavy paper. Mats, including mounted and floating mats, may be used.
- The art should be no smaller than 8" x 10" but no larger than 18" x 24", **INCLUDING** mat.
