RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING A GRANT FOR THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE FROM THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY FOR BODY ARMOR REPLACEMENT FUND (BARF) PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") recognizes a continuing need to assist the Prosecutor's Office, the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety ("Department") and law enforcement in offsetting the costs of purchasing bulletproof body vests for law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the grant reimbursement is for a five (5) year period from January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2029, with total funding of \$2,156.72.

- 1. The project grant on file with the Clerk of the Board is approved and accepted.
2. The County Prosecutor, the Chief Finance Officer, the Project Contact Person from the Prosecutor's Office, as well as any other necessary parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all project grant documents provided by the Division.
3. Five (5) fully executed copies of this resolution shall be provided to the County Prosecutor forthwith.
