RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND FOR AS-NEEDED USE OF MOBILE TRAFFIC SIGNALS

WHEREAS, the County of Cumberland and County of Salem both have the legal authority under the Uniform Shared Service and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq. (the "Act") to enter into a Shared Service Agreement with any local unit to provide or receive any service that each local unit could perform on its own; and

WHEREAS, each entity seeks to lower costs of services to their respective residents and each desires to seek ways to share and/or consolidate services where possible; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem desires the use of a mobile traffic signal in possession of the County of Cumberland on an as-needed basis; and

WHEREAS, the County of Cumberland is desirous of providing the use of any available mobile traffic signal(s) in its possession in exchange for reimbursement of out-of-pocket expendables, such as fuel and time spent by Cumberland County employees in transporting and setting up any such signals; and

WHEREAS, the term of this as-needed relationship would be for a period of one (1) year commencing upon full signature of the Shared Services Agreement and may be renewed by mutual written consent thereafter; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to accomplish the foregoing, the County of Cumberland and Salem County are desirous of entering into a Shared Service Agreement to foster and promote the foregoing purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners as follows:

1. That the Shared Service Agreement between Salem County and the Cumberland County be approved for the As-Needed Use of Mobile Traffic Signal(s).
2. That the Director and Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized to execute said agreement in the form on file.
